IN-RE-ENRON-ERISA-LITIGATION

I object to the partial class action settlement for the reason stated below:

There are hundreds of old retired Northern Natural Gas/Enron Employees that have thousands of shares of stock in the 401K, ESOP, and Cash Balance Plans. These are people who were encouraged to save for retirement and their estates, and worked hard from 20 to 40 years for the company, and who were in the stock plan from the beginning.

These are people who were told by Enron Benefits Personnel to keep their stock, that Enron was in great financial shape--while the CEO's were cashing their stock out. Then later, no one at Benefits would talk to them, and then the stock was froze, and couldn't be sold. Some of this stock was purchased with money the employees paid taxes on, and money that came out of their paychecks.

I feel that with all these Partial-Class Action Settlements, the lawyers and law firms, and the employees who were in the plans for a short period of time will end up with too much of the money, and the employees who worked many years for the company will get very little or nothing.

The Court needs to have one class action settlement that would let the old employees recoup some of the money that they paid into the 401K and ESOP, and that was put into the Cash Balance Plans.
